Dear Parents and Carers,

YOUNG VOICES MANCHESTER ARENA: MONDAY 22 JANUARY 2018

The time is fast approaching for our Young Voices event at Manchester Arena on MONDAY 22nd JANUARY and the children are now in full swing with the preparations for this event.

Here is the essential information:

1. Children come into school as normal wearing a WHITE T-shirt/shirt or a Young voices T-shirt (if they purchased one). They will wear their school jumpers and school trousers as normal.
2. The coach is planning to leave school at 12noon. The children will have their school lunch as normal early at 11:30am. Any parents travelling on the coach need to be with us in the school entrance by 11:45am.
3. We arrive in Manchester around 2pm and we rehearse from 2:15pm until 5pm in the Arena.
4. Tea will be from 5pm – 6pm. **All the children will need a second pack-up for their tea. If you need to order a school pack-up, please indicate this on the form below.** To prevent accidents happening no glass containers or fizzy drinks please. Please ensure your child has enough to drink for the day.
5. Between 6pm and 7pm there will be a break time for the children. They can bring something small to do with them such as colouring or reading books. No electronics or large items. It must be made clear that school cannot accept any responsibility for any lost items.
6. The concert begins at 7pm. Parents with tickets are advised to be there in plenty of time and to be aware that there are security checks and large bags will not be allowed into the arena.

7. The concert will finish at around 9pm. ALL CHILDREN will come back to the coach and travel back to school on the coach as there are around 3,000 children taking part and it is not possible to locate people easily.
8. We aim to arrive back at school for around 11pm. School will be unlocked so you have a warm place to wait. We will regularly update the Young Voices Facebook Page so you know when to expect us and if we are held up at all.
9. Children who suffer from travel sickness will be advised to sit near the front of the coach. If you would like them to take a travel sick pill please ensure this is sent to school with your child in a named bag/envelope. They will also need one for the return journey. For those children who suffer from asthma, please ensure they take their inhaler with them. They will not be able to attend without it.
10. The coach will be leaving Sheffield as soon as it is able and aims to be back at school about 11pm. If for any reason we are delayed significantly, then the Group Leader will contact Mrs Neal who will inform parents by sending out a group text to the emergency contact numbers that have been supplied by parents.
11. The school will be open from 10.45pm to let parents wait for the children inside.
12. In the event of adverse weather conditions, and where the coach driver has taken advice from the police not to drive for safety reasons, then we will be cancelling this event.
13. The next morning, as it is a late and tiring night, children will be able to come to school anytime before lunchtime. YOU MUST INFORM THE OFFICE IF YOUR CHILD IS HAVING A SCHOOL DINNER ON THE TUESDAY.
