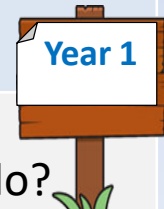

English Can you form lower case letters in the correct direction, starting and finishing in the right place? Can you write a sequence of sentences to form a narrative? Can you write a letter/ postcard? Can you use appropriate spacing between words? Can you use knowledge of phonemes to spell some words accurately? Can you join sentences using the conjunction 'and, but, so and because? Can you use capital letters, full stops, question marks and exclamation marks in your writing?	Maths Number and Measures. Can you compare, describe and solve practical problems for: mass/weight (e.g., heavy/light, heavier than, lighter than) capacity and volume (e.g. full/empty, more than, less than, half full, quarter full) and time (e.g., quicker, slower, earlier, later). Can you tell the time to the hour and draw the hands on a clock face to show these times? Can you can tell the time to half past the hour and draw the hands on a clock face to show these times? Can you recognise and know the value of different denominations of coins and notes? Can you solve practical addition and subtraction problems involving money?
Science Can you observe changes across the seasons? Can you name the four seasons in order? Can you observe and describe weather associated with the seasons? Can observe and describe how day length varies? Can you perform a test and record information on a chart or table?	Computing Can you talk about technology that is used at home and in school? Can use a safe part of the Internet to play and learn? Can you create a slide to show the differences between England and another country in the world? Can you create a fact file about the seasons?
Geography and History Can you identify the differences between the UK and Russia? Can you use a map, atlas or globe to locate the UK and Russia? Can you identify seasonal changes in the UK and Russia? Can you identify why a Meerkat could not live in Russia?	Art and Design Can you create moods in your drawing and paintings? Can you communicate something about yourself in a drawings or painting? Can you cut, roll and coil materials such as clay, dough or plasticine? Can you use a simple painting IT programme to create a picture? Can create a picture which puts emphasis on happiness or sadness?
