Summer Fun!

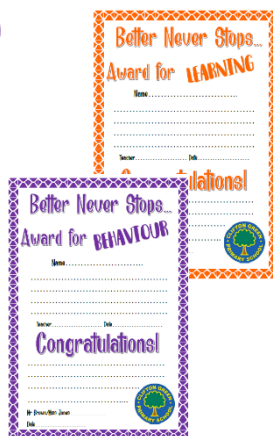
