**YOUNG VOICES SHEFFIELD ARENA: WEDNESDAY 8<sup>th</sup> JANUARY 2020**

The time is fast approaching for our Young Voices event at Sheffield Arena on WEDNESDAY 8th JANUARY. Here is the essential information:

1. Children come into school as normal wearing a WHITE T-shirt/shirt or a Young voices T-shirt (if they purchased one). They will wear their school jumpers and school trousers/skirts as normal.
2. The coach is planning to leave school at 12:30pm. The children will have their school lunch as normal early at 12 noon
3. We arrive in Sheffield around 2pm and we rehearse from 2:15pm until 5pm in the Arena.
4. The children will need to bring everything in a strong carrier bag as no rucksacks will be allowed into the arena. Pack up bags should be fine.
5. Tea will be from 5pm – 6pm. **All the children will need a pack-up for their tea. If you need to order a school pack-up, please indicate this on the form below.** To prevent accidents happening no glass containers or fizzy drinks please. Please ensure your child has enough to drink for the day.
6. Between 6pm and 7pm there will be a break time for the children. They can bring something small to do with them such as colouring or reading books. No electronics or large items. It must be made clear that school cannot accept any responsibility for any lost items.

7. The concert begins at 7pm. Parents with tickets are advised to be there in plenty of time and to be aware that there are security checks and large bags will not be allowed into the arena.
8. The concert will finish at around 9pm. ALL CHILDREN will come back to the coach and travel back to school on the coach as there are around 3,000 children taking part and it is not possible to locate people easily.
9. We aim to arrive back at school for around 11pm. School will be unlocked so you have a warm place to wait. We will regularly update the Young Voices Facebook Page so you know when to expect us and if we are held up at all.
10. Children who suffer from travel sickness will be advised to sit near the front of the coach. If you would like them to take a travel sick tablet please ensure this is sent to school with your child in a named bag/envelope. They will also need one for the return journey. For those children who suffer from asthma, please ensure they take their inhaler with them.
11. The coach will be leaving Sheffield as soon as it is able and aims to be back at school about 11pm. If for any reason we are delayed significantly, then the Group Leader will contact Lisa who will inform parents. This message will also be on the Facebook Page.
12. The next morning, as it is a late and tiring night, children will be able to come to school anytime before 11am but MUST be in by then. YOU MUST INFORM THE OFFICE IF YOUR CHILD IS HAVING A SCHOOL DINNER ON THE THURSDAY.
