The school will do its best to:

- Provide an environment which has been risk assessed in response to the COVID-19 infection and Local Authority Risk assessment (limited classroom sizes, isolated 'bubbles' of children and adults, regular cleaning).
- Adhere to the social distancing rules as set out by the government as much as we reasonably can.
- Provide a curriculum that meets the needs of your child's well-being, mental health and academic needs.
- Contact parents/carers if your child displays symptoms of COVID-19 and support your child in a designated safe area until they are collected.
- Follow NHS Test and Trace procedures.
- Continue our clear and consistent approach to managing behaviour for children as set out in the Behaviour Policy as well the expectations outlines in this agreement.
- Provide every child with an individual water bottle.
- Communicate between home and school through phone, email, social media, and the school website.



Parent

To help my child at school, I will do my best to understand that:

- If my child, or anyone in my household, shows symptoms of COVID-19, I will not send them to school, we will self-isolate for 14 days as a family, I will get them tested and I will let the school know as soon as possible via telephone.
- If my child shows symptoms of COVID-19 at school, I will collect my child immediately. I will get them tested and I will let the school know the outcome as soon as possible. I will follow NHS and Public Health advice.
- Only one parent/carer should drop off and pick up and I will adhere to the social distancing.
- When dropping off and picking up, I will strictly stick to the school timings for my child and I will not stay on school site any longer than necessary.
- When dropping off, my child will remove any face mask or gloves they are wearing.
- My child will not bring any unnecessary items into school with them.
- I will not be allowed into the school without a pre- arranged appointment – make appointments via telephone or email.
- If my child is considered to be repeatedly unsafe and unwilling or unable to follow health and safety rules and guidelines, school will want to discuss this with me.



Child

I will do my best to:

- Stay within my 'bubble' and follow the rules that keep me safe.
- Wash my hands as soon as I go into school.
- Tell an adult if I feel unwell.
- I will not bring any unnecessary items into school with me.
- Keep my equipment and belongings to myself.
- Only enter and exit the school building from the designated gates/doors.
- Follow the catch it-bin it-kill it rules coughing and sneezing into elbow or tissue and disposing in a lidded bin.
- Regularly wash my hands using soap and water for 20 seconds.
- Try to keep my distance from others and avoid face-to-face contact or touching others.
