



## CGPS Remote Learning - Parent/Carer Guidance for Years 2-6

If your child is absent from school for the following reasons, they will be recorded as an 'X' on the register and we will provide remote education:

- a child has shown symptoms and is awaiting a test/result **and is well enough to access learning**;
- a household member has symptoms or has tested positive and therefore the household is self-isolating;
- NHS Test and Trace has advised the child to self-isolate due to recent contact with a person testing positive for COVID-19;
- a child (or family member) are advised to shield themselves (if rates of infection rise locally or government guidance changes).

It is now a requirement that children access learning from home when they are not in school. At Clifton Green, this will be administered through Google Classroom. **If your child is unable to get onto Google Classroom from home, please inform school immediately so support or alternative work can be provided.**

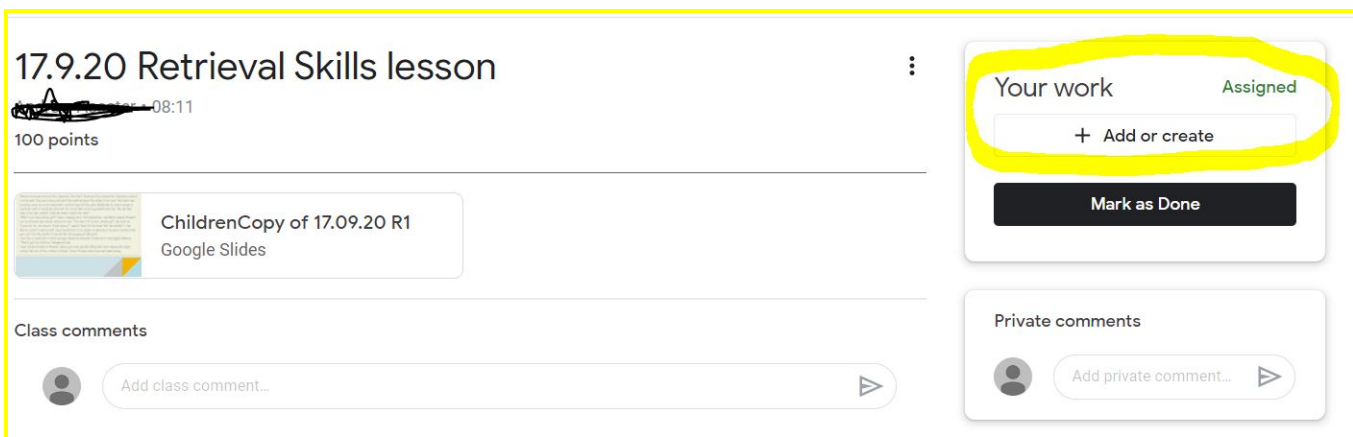
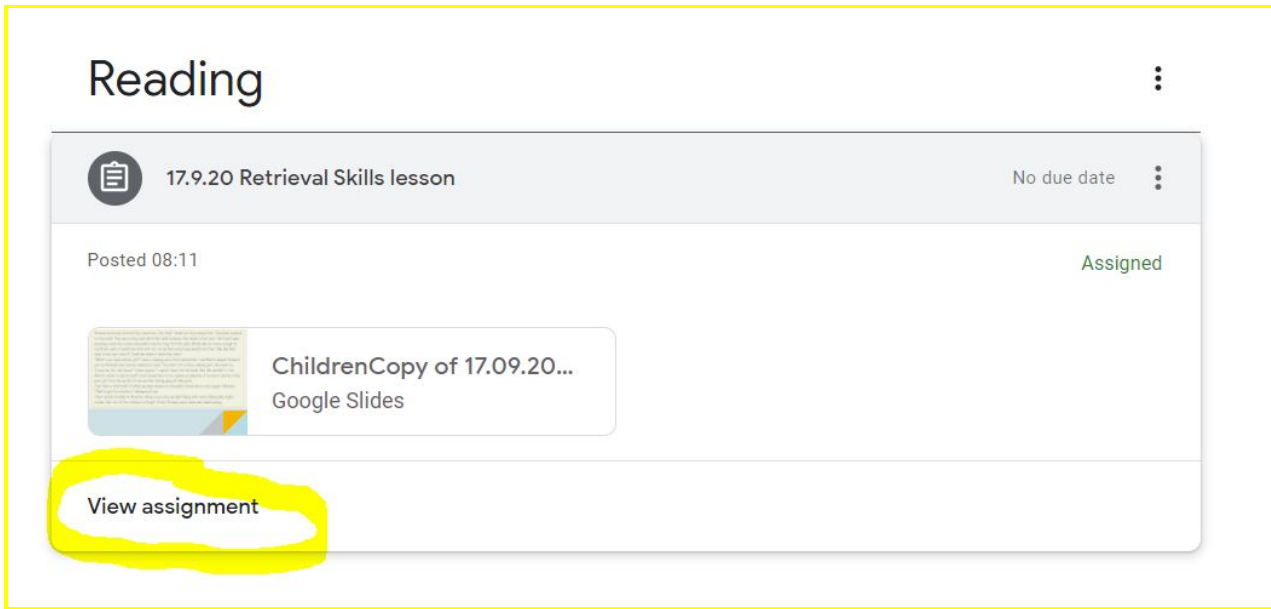

### Online Learning

- Each day, a teacher will contact your child on their individual Google Classroom Stream;
- The Google Classroom Stream will be the primary method of communication around a child's remote learning for both pupils and parents. Please see Classwork>Remote Learning;
- Each day, the emphasis should be on 15 minutes of reading practise (using a book or Reading Planet) and 15 minutes each of the following:
  - Y2 - phonics, NumBots/TimesTables Rockstars, a Fluent in 5 activity and Spelling Shed work
  - Y3/Y4/Y5/Y6 - TimesTables Rockstars, a Fluent in 5 activity and Spelling Shed work.

- Additionally, instruction will be given for 2 additional sessions a day which will be clear on your child's timetable (also shared on Google Classroom).
- Teachers will provide links to the Oak National Academy resources and/or White Rose Maths work primarily as this has been designed for remote learning however additional school resources may be provided.
- Where work can be completed online a teacher can see the work that has been submitted. Where a task is on paper or more practical, children can share images of the work by using the instructions below.

When children go into Classwork in Google Classroom, they can click 'View Assignment' (Image 1) and then on the right hand side it allows them to 'Add or Create' work. When selected, this gives options of how to upload work or images to the Classroom for the teacher to see.
